REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER

REGULAR REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER GALAPAGOS

- Valid original passport.
- Mandatory medical and travel insurance.
- Transit Control Card.
- Galapagos National Park entrance fee.

NEW REQUIREMENTS DUE TO COVID-19

All passengers must comply with the following requirements updated and regulated by the competent authorities of the country.

After reviewing the report provided by the Technical Committee directed by the Ministry of Health, the National Authority for Emergencies decided to delete the criteria for entering continental and insular Ecuador beginning Thursday, October 20th, 2022 at 00h01. With this decision, the certificate or vaccination card, as well as the PCR or antigen test, are no longer mandatory for international tourists arriving at our destination through air or land borders.



- If there is an increase in Covid 19 cases in any country, recommendations for travelers from that nation might be implemented in a targeted manner.
- It is important to remember that the "Traveler's Health Declaration" process remains the same and must be completed digitally prior to boarding. - It is worth mentioning that travelers who complete the digital form are no longer required to produce the form to the Ministry of Health at the point of entry. These measures are the results of the Ecuadorian National Government's efforts to encourage a sustainable recovery of multiple economic activities as well as a boost to the Ecuadorian touristic sector so that more visitors may come to our nation.




PROCESS FOR PASSENGERS DEPARTING TO GALAPAGOS FROM QUITO OR GUAYAQUIL AIRPORTS

- Passengers will pass through immigration control.
- Passengers must collect their luggage at the airport.

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- Masks are mandatory.
- Passengers should avoid wearing metal and packing objects that are not allowed in carry-on luggage.
- It is recommended that passengers avoid heavy carry-on luggage. Allowed weight is 5 kg (11 lbs). (subject to change)
- Passengers should have all documents, indicated in the "Requirements for the entry of passengers" section, with them.





• Important: Passengers must abide by the regulations of the Galapagos National Park, the Galapagos Government Council, the Ministry of Health of Ecuador, and the Airports.
