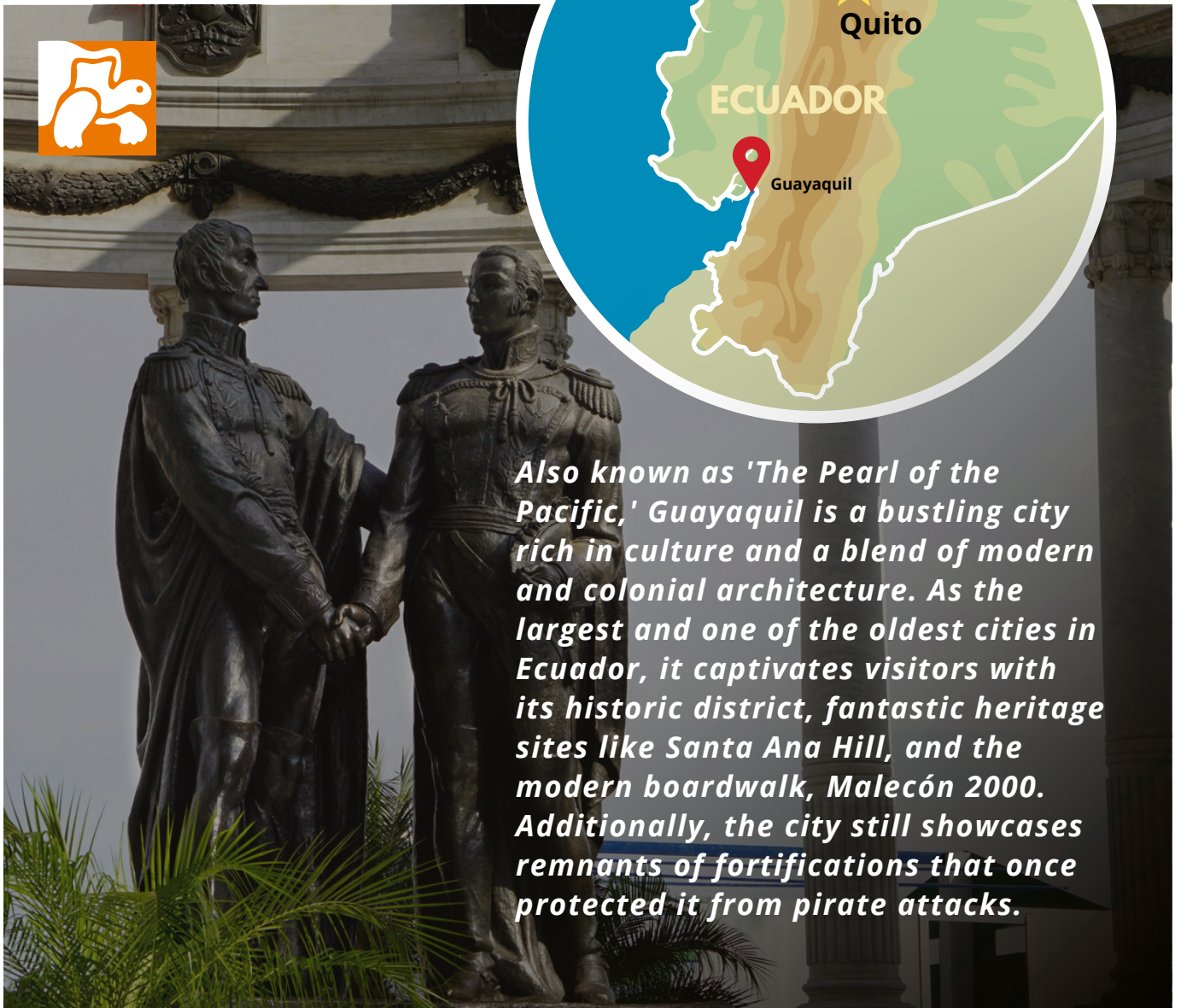


GUAYAQUIL'S ART STAIRCASE

Half Day Tour in Guayaquil



Also known as 'The Pearl of the Pacific,' Guayaquil is a bustling city rich in culture and a blend of modern and colonial architecture. As the largest and one of the oldest cities in Ecuador, it captivates visitors with its historic district, fantastic heritage sites like Santa Ana Hill, and the modern boardwalk, Malecón 2000. Additionally, the city still showcases remnants of fortifications that once protected it from pirate attacks.

Reaching the summit, you'll be treated to a breathtaking panoramic view of Guayaquil city and its port. Here, you'll have the opportunity to visit the iconic lighthouse, complete with its internal staircase, and the colonial chapel located in Plaza de Honores, offering additional scenic viewpoints and excellent photo opportunities.

A scenic drive along Malecon Simon Bolivar, showcasing the city's vibrant atmosphere, will take you to Santa Ana Hill, one of Guayaquil's most emblematic sites. As you ascend the renowned trail of over 400 steps connecting the boardwalk to the hilltop, you will have some time to explore the local shops, relax in the gardens, and browse for souvenirs.



Next, venture into the lively neighborhood of Las Peñas, characterized by its colorful shops, charming cafes, and winding cobblestone passages that will lead you to vibrant houses transformed into art studios, where you can admire local artwork and even meet the talented artists themselves.



On the drive back to the hotel, you'll pass important landmarks such as the Hospital General and the city's impressive main cemetery, providing further insight into Guayaquil's rich history and culture. The tour concludes with a drop-off at your hotel.
